- The ministry continues to operate on a cash basis and in the black. Nothing is purchased or shipped unless the money is in the bank.
- The current back order for **Tracts** and **Coins** is 2220. One donation of \$5,550 would bring the Gospel message of Jesus Christ to 2220 of those troops who are waiting to hear God's plan for their life.

GENERAL INFORMATION:

- It is not just the price of gasoline and groceries that has gone up. The cost of shipping and metal for our coins has also been affected. It now takes \$2.50 to get a Prayer Tract and a Prayer Reminder Coin to a Chaplain any place in the World. Still inexpensive considering that great evangelistic tools are being placed into the hands of some of God's best evangelists.
